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Policy Statement

As a company we endeavour to use sustainable materials wherever viable, this will be achieved through careful planning throughout the design, manufacture and construction stages. In the event of temporary works we will produce policies and agreements where materials can be stored and reused thus reducing the volume of goods being produced. This then in effect reduces energy resources used in production stages of the products that are required.

This will be achieved through coordination through an evaluated and approved supply chain ensuring that our standards are always met or exceeded.
